

Gravestone of David Overmier

David's mother, Eva, died in 1823 and on March 1, 1824, his father married a second time to Sarah Harnet, the widow of John Harnet. A few months later, on Oct. 28, 1824, at the age of 23, David married Elizabeth Harnet, Sarah's daughter from her first marriage. Elizabeth gave birth to eleven children before she died at the age of 43 in 1851: Emeline, Aaron, Sarah, James, Mary E., Catharine, Elizabeth, Peter, Christina, Lydia Caroline, and Barbara A. (died in childhood).


David was a wagon maker. He lived in New Reading until he passed away on Mar. 16, 1874 at the age of 72, fifty-one years to the day that his mother passed away. He was buried in the New Reading Cemetery, where his gravestone bears the spelling "Overmier." Many of his descendants remained in Ohio, many in the vicinity of Overmyertown in Perry County. Others moved to FL, MI, IN, IL, WV, KS, SD, AZ, ID, OR. New Lebanon Evangelical Lutheran Burial Ground, Junction City, Perry Co., OH, where his gravestone spells the name "Overmyer."
